INSTRUCTION TO GRADUATE STUDENTS SEEKING FOR AUTHENTICITY CERTIFICATION

What is Turnitin?

Turnitin is an internet-based plagiarism detection system, which compares content of a paper against a database of sources.

Files should be in MS Word format. To avoid unnecessary errors, you are strongly advised to use the 'spellchecker' function of MS Word.

Before submitting your thesis/dissertation, ensure that your paper was not previously subjected for authenticity testing using Turnitin

STEPS IN OBTAINING AUTHENTICITY CERTIFICATION

<u>Step</u>

Send a request for Authenticity
Test to the Graduate Research
Office.

The Graduate Research Office (GRESO) will assess your thesis/dissertation





After their initial assessment on your thesis/dissertation, GRESO will send us a copy of your thesis/dissertation together with your official receipt to the Publication Office (thru e-mail).

<u>Step</u>

Upon our receipt of your thesis/dissertation, we will resubject your paper to antiplagiarism test.







If the Similarity Index Result is 25% and below, you will receive an e-mail informing that you can claim your Authenticity Certificate at our office (Rm. 202 Orata Bldg.). If your Similarity Index Result is above 25%, your need to revise your paper and resubmit the revised paper for re-run to acquire certification.
