# **Details on Authorship**

Authorship gives credit and implies accountability for published work, which has academic, social, and financial implications. It is crucial to ensure that contributors receive proper credit as authors and that those recognized as authors understand their responsibility and accountability for the published content.

## TYPES OF AUTHORSHIP

### **Co-Author**

A person who has contributed significantly to a journal article, sharing responsibility and accountability for the research results.

# **Corresponding Author**

When multiple authors contribute to an article, one person is designated as the corresponding author. This individual handles all correspondence related to the article and signs the publishing agreement on behalf of all authors. They are responsible for ensuring that all authors' contact details are accurate, agreeing on the order of their names in the article, and verifying the correctness of affiliations.

#### As a Co-Author:

- Has contributed significantly to the reported work, whether in conception, study, design, execution, data acquisition, analysis, and interpretation or across all these areas.
- Drafted or wrote the article or substantially revised or critically reviewed it.
- Agreed on the journal to which the article will be submitted.
- Reviewed and agreed on all versions of the article before submission, during revision, the final version accepted for publication, and any significant changes made during the proofing stage.
- Agree to take responsibility and be accountable for the article's content, sharing the responsibility to resolve any questions regarding the accuracy or integrity of the published work.

Simply gathering data or funding the study does not qualify for authorship. General supervision of the research process is also not enough. The order of authors should reflect each contributor's relative contribution to the study and the manuscript.

# **Corresponding Author:**

Co-authors must have a consensus on who will serve as the corresponding author. This individual is responsible for ensuring agreement among all co-authors on every aspect of the article before submission, including the authorship list, the order of names, and the correct affiliations.

The corresponding author also handles communication with co-authors regarding editorial queries and represents all co-authors in interactions throughout the submission, peer review, production, and post-publication phases. They sign the publishing agreement on behalf of all listed authors.

# **AFFILIATIONS**

Author affiliation in the manuscript should reflect the institution where the research was conducted and details of any funding received from that institution. If the author's affiliation has changed since completing the research, the author may acknowledge the new affiliation in a note. Typically, changes to affiliation cannot be made after the journal has accepted your article.

**Important Note:** It is important to agree on the corresponding author and co-authors' order and check all affiliations and contact details before submitting. Please complete the <u>Author Declaration and Contributions form</u> and submit it to the journal before publication.

# **ACKNOWLEDGMENTS**

Anyone who contributed to the article, such as providing technical help, formatting, translation, or significant scholarly input but doesn't meet the criteria for authorship, should be listed by name and affiliation in the 'Acknowledgments' section.

Authors are responsible for informing and getting permission from these individuals. This process should include sharing the article with them so they can confirm how their contribution is being acknowledged.

Any use of AI tools for content generation, such as large language models, must be mentioned in the article. Authors must ensure their article's content is valid, original, and ethical, using such tools responsibly and following editorial policies on authorship and publishing ethics.

## **BIBLIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Please provide a brief biographical note for each author. Each bio should be relatively short, not exceeding 70 words. Authors are responsible for keeping all original data related to their work and should be ready to share it with the journal editorial office if requested.

## **CHANGES TO AUTHORSHIP**

- Changes to authorship after submission should be rare and must align with our authorship criteria.
- Contact the Journal Editorial Office or Editorial team to request an authorship change. You must complete a <u>Request Form for Change of Authorship</u>, signed by all authors (including those added or removed). The Editor (and sometimes the publisher) will review the request.
- The Editor has the final say on any authorship changes and can reject requests that do not follow our policies.
- If the corresponding author changes before publication, notify the journal editor and production editor, confirming that all authors agree to the change.
- Changes to co-authors or corresponding authors after publication may be considered according to COPE guidelines. Refer to our corrections policy for details. Requests must include a completed Request Form for Change of Authorship.
